Kindness (Pink Shirt) Day

It was a special day on Wednesday, as we celebrated Kindness Day! We started with an assembly where we learned about our school social responsibility language, listened to some incredible musical performances from Divisions 1, 10, 12, 14, and the choir related to kindness and heard from one of our students to kick off a food bank drive (see next page).

After the assembly, we worked with buddy classes on an activity related to caring for ourselves, others, and our place.

Ramadan Food Drive!

At our assembly, we heard from one of our students, Misha, who came to us with the idea of having a food drive to benefit the Richmond Food Bank! Misha shared that her family is observing Ramadan. During Ramadan, Muslims emphasize service, compassion, and helping those in need. The community organizes food drives through Ismaili CIVIC to support local food banks and teach children the importance of giving back.



We were so lucky to learn more about Ramadan and how the Muslim community contributes to those in need in Richmond! We are supporting Misha's food drive and are hoping that all Spul'u'kwuks students can contribute at least one item. Social Responsibility at Spul'u'kwuks

This year, we have revisited our Social Responsibility language to look for ways to add meaning for our students. Families that have been at the school for some time will be familiar with the "SOAR" acronym, which stands for Safety, Ownership, Acceptance, and Respect.

To make the language more accessible for our younger students, we have added "Caring" language. Specifically, Caring for Self, Caring for Others, and Caring for Place.

We will use the "Caring" language with all of our students from Kindergarten to Grade 7. Classes may also add the more abstract concept of SOAR when talking about social responsibility.
