COMMUNICATING STUDENT LEARNING




Next week we will be holding conferences and want to share what these will look like. Teachers have been contacting parents to book a time to speak with you. If you have not heard from your child's teacher yet, please first check your email and then reach out to the teacher.

Last week we shared with you that there are changes coming to how we provide learning updates to parents. As per the Ministry's direction, teachers will share information about your child's learning with a focus on:

- Literacy
- Numeracy
- Social-Emotional Learning

In addition, student **reflection** on one of the Core Competencies will be shared with you. A reflection is an example of how your child looks back on their learning and is the first step towards preparing a Core Competency **Self-Assessment** for the end of the term. The self-assessment will be posted to your child's portfolio. It is possible that some teachers may combine the reflection and self-assessment into one document.
