The City of Richmond is committed to ensuring all youth in Richmond have a safe, healthy, and enriching journey to adulthood. The Youth Strategy:

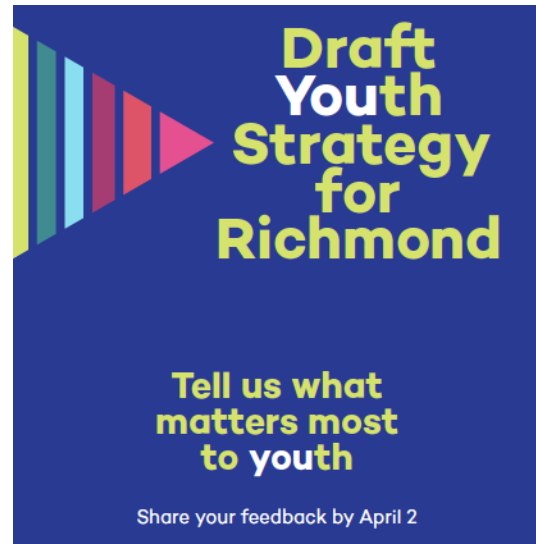
- will guide the City's work with and for young people in Richmond aged 13-24 years;
