#### FROM OUR PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE: IMMUNIZATIONS



The next Spul'u'kwuks Kindergarten, Grade 1, Grade 6 and Grade 7 immunization clinic will be on June 19.

If your child is required to receive an immunization, you would have received a paper notice with clinic and specific immunization information. This notice was sent home with your child.

Note, some immunizations are given over multiple doses over a longer period of time, to stimulate an effective immune response and protect against disease. Previous consent is valid for 2 years in order to complete an immunization series.


Contact us (not the school) prior to the day of clinic if:

- 1. Your child has received any immunizations at your family doctor's office, pharmacy, or a travel clinic.
- 2. You have received a notice <u>and</u> you no longer consent to your child to receiving immunizations at school this year.
- 3. You have questions
