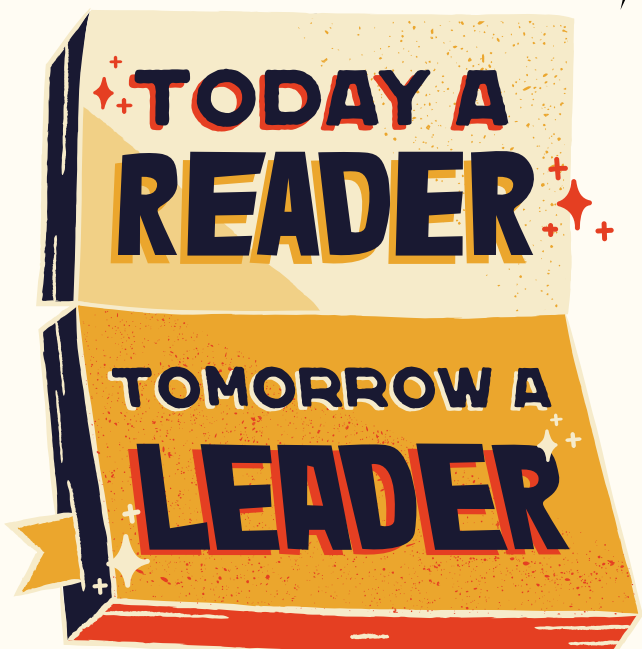

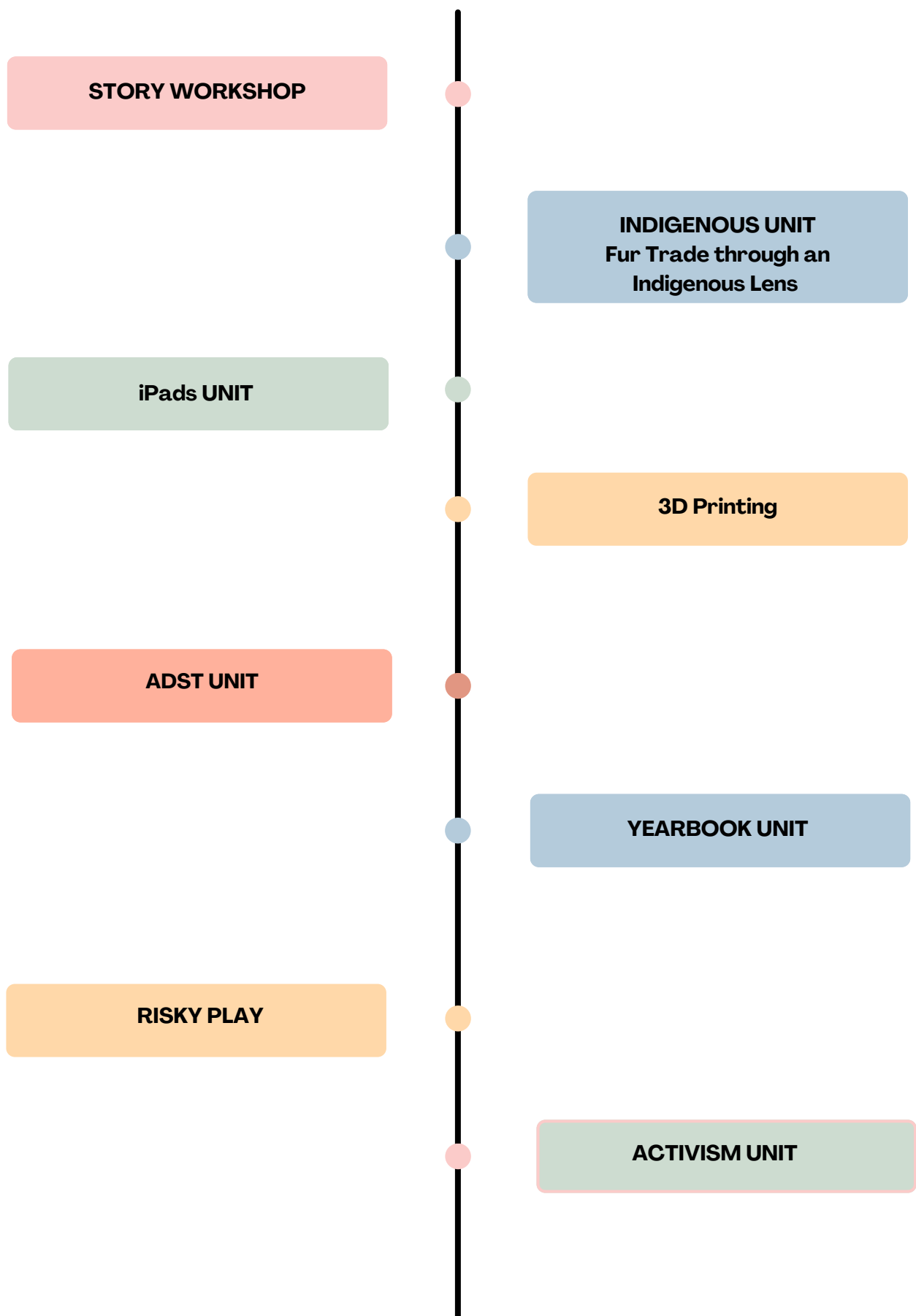

COLLABORATIONS



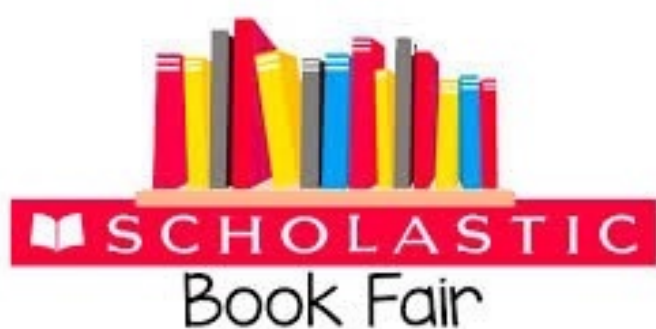
