## **Track Meet on Monday**

**If your child is not attending the track meet**, a regular school day has been planned for them. Teachers have let students know which room they will be in and where to go on Monday. If they forget, Mrs. Tilton in the office will be able to remind them.

**If your child IS attending the track meet**, they have been reminded today of all details in the permission forms you received and have been debriefed on what to expect at the meet. Please review those forms and details again yourself so that students are set up to have a successful day (what to bring, what to wear, timing, etc.).

- Since it is an all-weather track, the meet will be cancelled only under extremely poor weather conditions. If the meet is postponed, students will be informed via the school's website, Twitter and email. If the meet is cancelled, our alternative date is the next day, May 27. Your child can go to school for a regular day if the meet is cancelled. The decision whether or not to cancel will be made by the district by 7am.
- Your child will bring home their event stickers today. Please do NOT remove them from the sticker backing but attach them to your child's shirt with the provided safety pins on Monday morning. Please do not forget them.
- Students cannot use personal electronic devices during the track meet, as it is a school event. If your child needs to bring a device to the track to contact you afterward, it must stay turned off and in their backpack until the meet is over. We cannot be responsible for the safety of devices at the track.

Please remember that only students who are participating and have a signed permission form may come to the track meet. All other students should be at school.

#### Positions Open for Election 2025 -2026 School Year

#### **PAC Executive Positions**

(Executive roles typically involve participating in one short Executive Committee meeting per month, which may be held in person, virtually, or through group chats. In addition, there is one general PAC meeting per month held virtually.)

Chair (1 position)

Leads PAC and Executive Committee meetings, works closely with the school administration, oversees PAC activities, and supports communication between families and the school.

- Vice Chair (1 position) Supports the Chair, steps in when the Chair is unavailable, and helps coordinate PAC initiatives and communications.
- Treasurer (1 position) Manages PAC finances, including bank deposits, writing cheques, and preparing financial reports for meetings.
- Secretary (1 position)
   Prepares meeting agendas and takes minutes. Assists the Chair in writing and distributing PAC notices and communications.
- Members-at-Large (2 positions) Provide general support to the Executive Committee as needed.

#### PAC Associate Positions

(These roles require less time commitment and are perfect for those looking to help in specific areas)

Hot Lunch Coordinators (2 positions)

Manage orders using the Munch-a-Lunch platform and coordinate lunch distribution on hot lunch days.

- Canada Day Run Coordinators (2 positions)
   Organize and distribute juice boxes after the Canada Day Run.
- Sports Day Coordinators (2 positions) Coordinate the parent snack station and recruit volunteers for pizza lunch.

Family Photo Coordinators (2 positions)
 Schedule dates with the photography company and help families with check-in on photo day.

- RDPA Representative (1 position) Attend RDPA (Richmond District PAC Association) meetings and share updates with our PAC.
- Traffic Safety Committee Coordinator (1 position) Help coordinate volunteers for morning traffic safety and patrol during drop-off time.
