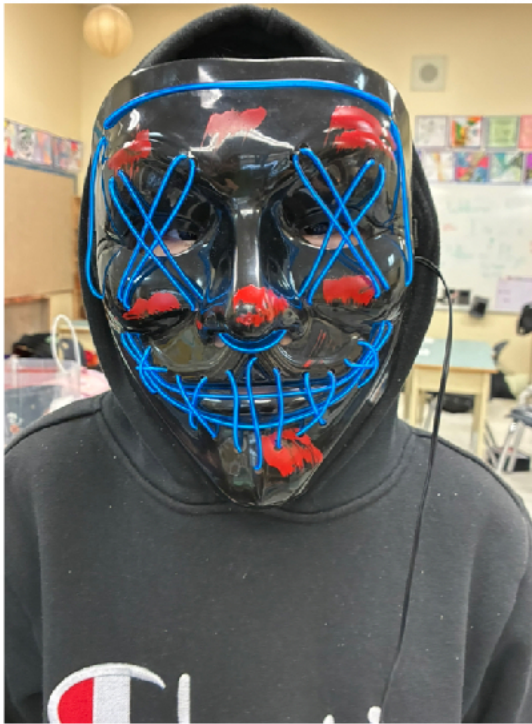

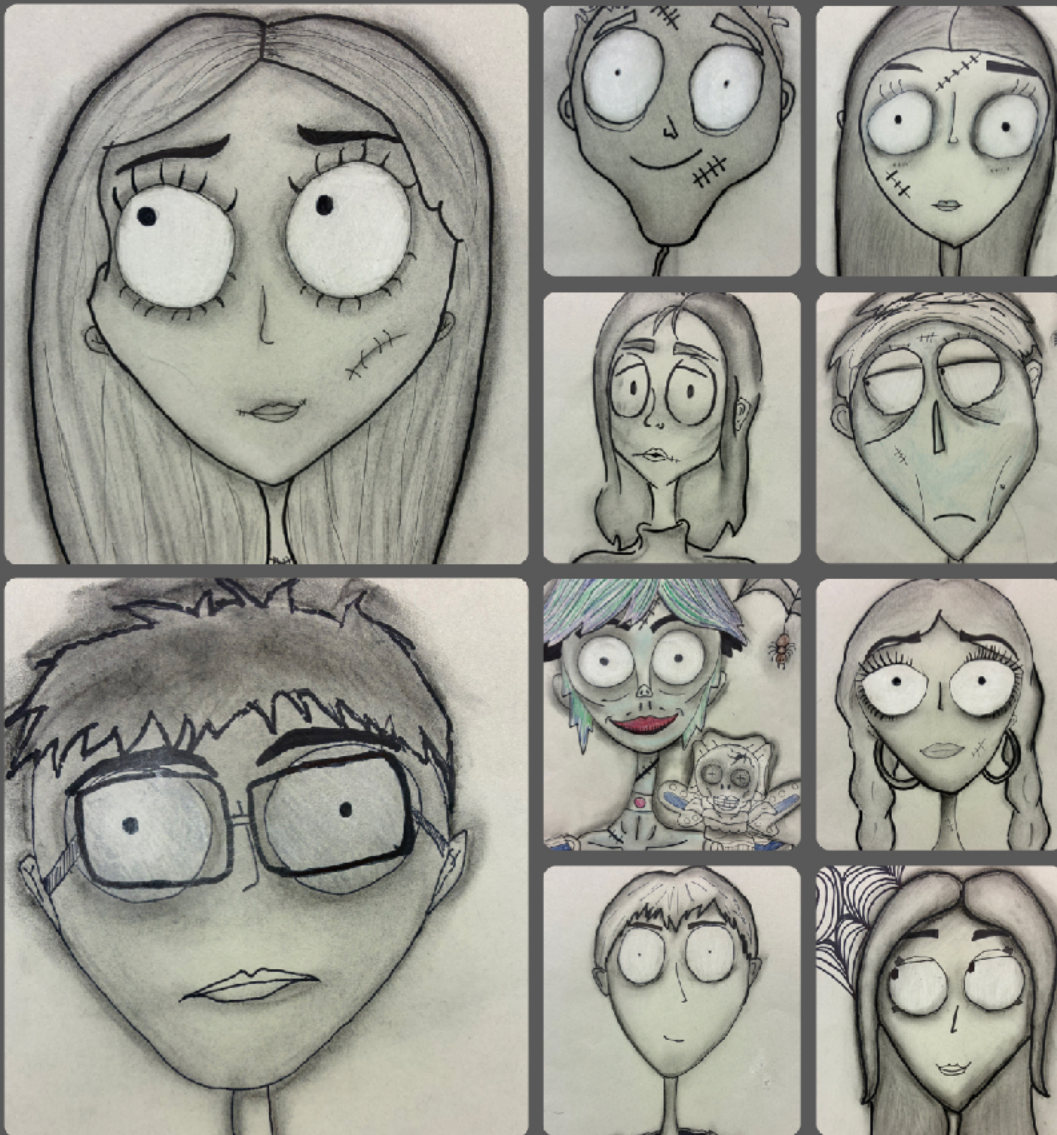


Happy Halloween!
