Community Outreach

This week, RCMP, City of Richmond Bylaws Team, and volunteers (organized through ICBC) were around our school to do a Community Outreach called, "Think of Me".

The purpose was to address road safety concerns by giving drivers cards designed by children to remind them about proper road safety.

We share the responsibility to keep our children safe. That means we must follow the "rules of the road". We understand that families do not get in their vehicles with an intent to cause harm, but some of the choices being made on the road can do just that. We saw some great examples of safe driving (Thank you!), but also saw the need for some reminders, which include:

- Following the speed limit
- Observing parking/stopping signs
- Using signals when turning
- Not making u-turns
- Putting cell phones away when behind the wheel
- Making sure children are wearing seatbelts until the vehicle stops moving
- Using the crosswalks
- Not pulling into other people's driveways/complexes



We observed that drivers who were not following the above were causing significant delays in traffic flow.

It was also suggested to us more families could be walking instead of driving. This will reduce congestion in the school zone, making it safer for everyone. If you can't walk the whole way, consider parking further from the school and walking the rest of the way in.

We have some work to do before the next visit. Let's show that our community is the most responsible and safest in Richmond!

Over the last 7 weeks our primary students participated in our first **"Spul'u'kwuks Reader's Choice."** We curated 7 unique picture books and each week primary students read one of the stories in the library. This week students voted on their favourite book.... Ask your child: "what book did you vote for?"

The winning book will receive the "Spul'u'kwuks Students' Choice Award" sticker and a copy of the book will be provided to each primary classroom.

Why is it important students evaluate literature?

We want to invoke critical thinking skills in our student. By reflecting, comparing, and evaluating the books, our students are transitioning from passive readers to active thinkers. Reader's choice is a fun and engaging way for our students to practice these important skills and since it requires no writing to participate, every student can access this activity.
