Track and Field

Intermediate students (Gr. 4-7) have been practicing their track and field skills during Physical and Health Education classes and also in grade groups over four afternoons during our Track Attack practices at school.

On May 27th, all Intermediate students (Grades 4-7) and their teachers will be going on a Field Trip to Minoru to participate in Track and Field events.

This year, we have a revised Track and Field format that is a Field Trip, guided by district principles that prioritize maximizing participation, building skills and confidence through sport, promoting lifelong enjoyment of physical activity, emphasizing joy, fair play, and teamwork, and fostering respectful relationships and a strong sense of community. With the new format, all students are able to participate in all events (if they wish) and can choose to compete competitively or for fun.

For parents/guardians of Grade 3-7 students who are interested in an extra-curricular opportunity to compete against students from other jurisdictions, there is the BC Elementary Track and Field Championships hosted by Kajaks Track and Field Club. This is an individual meet and not a school sponsored event, and is open to all students. For more information, please see the poster below.
