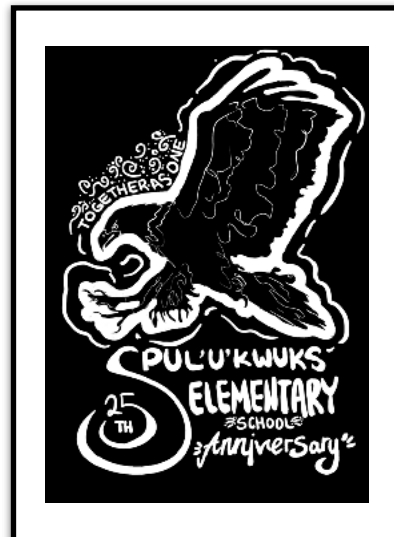
25th Anniversary Celebration

Things to Know:

- Grade 1-3 Cash Only
- Grade 4-7 Cash or Debit Card- Please do not send a credit card with your child! (You must trust your child to use a debit card—we do not issue refunds if a child misuses a debit card).
- We will accept credit cards from an adult after school June 2nd and 3rd - 2:45-3:30 and before school on Thursday June 4th
- Popular books often need to be ordered--- and usually arrive within 1 week.
