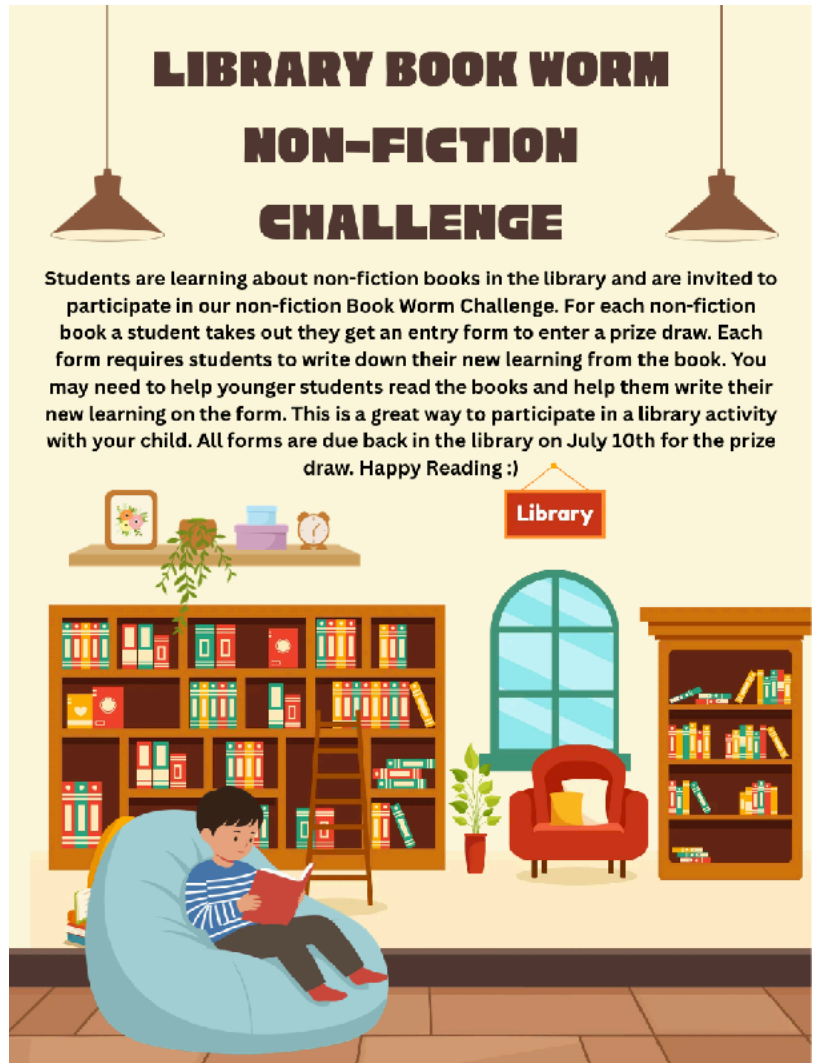

LIBRARY BOOK WORM NON-FICTION CHALLENGE

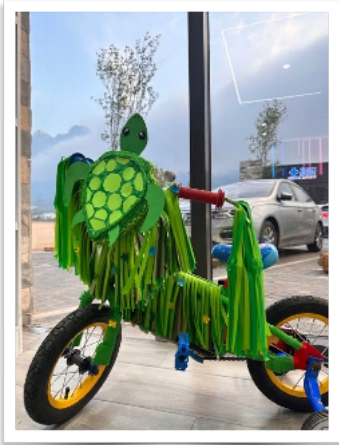
Sports Day 2026

This year, Sports Day has a new format! Students will stay with their classroom teacher and move from station to station as a class. Teachers have divided their class into four different colour teams, and they will compete against each other. This way, students will be with a familiar adult throughout the day.

8:30 - 8:45 am – Bike & Scooter Drop-Off

- Bikes and scooters will be dropped off at the **mural at the back of the school**
- Helmets are mandatory for all participants
- **No** motorized scooters/bikes or skateboards permitted
- We encourage students to decorate their bike in their team colour - red, yellow, green, or blue (see photos for examples)
- Mr. Farrugia and Ms. Wong will be in the drop-off zone to help students when they arrive

8:45 - 9:00 am – Attendance & Parade Preparation

- Teachers take attendance in classrooms
- Students participating in the Wheels Parade will be called to the **mural at the back of the school**
- Primary teachers will help students put helmets on before sending them outside
- Teachers will be called to bring their classes outside to watch the parade and stand on one side of the parade route

9:00 – 9:20 am – Wheels Parade

9:30 - 11:30 am – Sports Day Stations. Classes begin at the station matching their division number (ex. Division 5 starts at Station 5). After the first station, teachers may move their class to ANY open station. There will be NO bell or signal to rotate. Please see the map for the location of stations. Students will have a break at one of the freezie stations.

11:30 am Stations End/Clean-Up – Listen for the bell. Teachers and students help clean up stations and grounds, then return to classrooms for lunch. Parents/Guardians may sign out their child(ren) from the classroom if they would like to have lunch outside with them.

Important Information!

The first day of school in September is Tuesday, September 8th.

Please remember that the expectations regarding extended absences are different at the beginning of the school year. While the district generally considers extended absences of 20 consecutive school days or less acceptable, students **must** be in attendance at the beginning of September.

If you have an emergency, or have an extenuating reason why your child will not be able to be in attendance LATER THAN 12:00 pm Wednesday, Sep. 9, 2026, **AND ON** or **BEFORE** Sep. 11, 2026, you must complete the Notice of Late Return, which can be found on our website. **Late return is not used to extend summer holidays.**

If your child is not returning on or before September 11, 2026, we cannot reserve a spot guaranteeing the ability to be enrolled in the school. There may be a need for placement at another school upon the student's late return.
