Goodbye Staff!

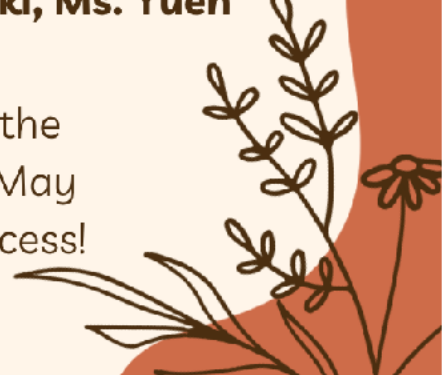


The end of the school year means saying goodbye to some staff. We wish the following staff members all the best in their future positions. Thank you for all that you have contributed to our community. We will miss you!

Gr. 1 – 7 students attend 8:45 – 9:45am

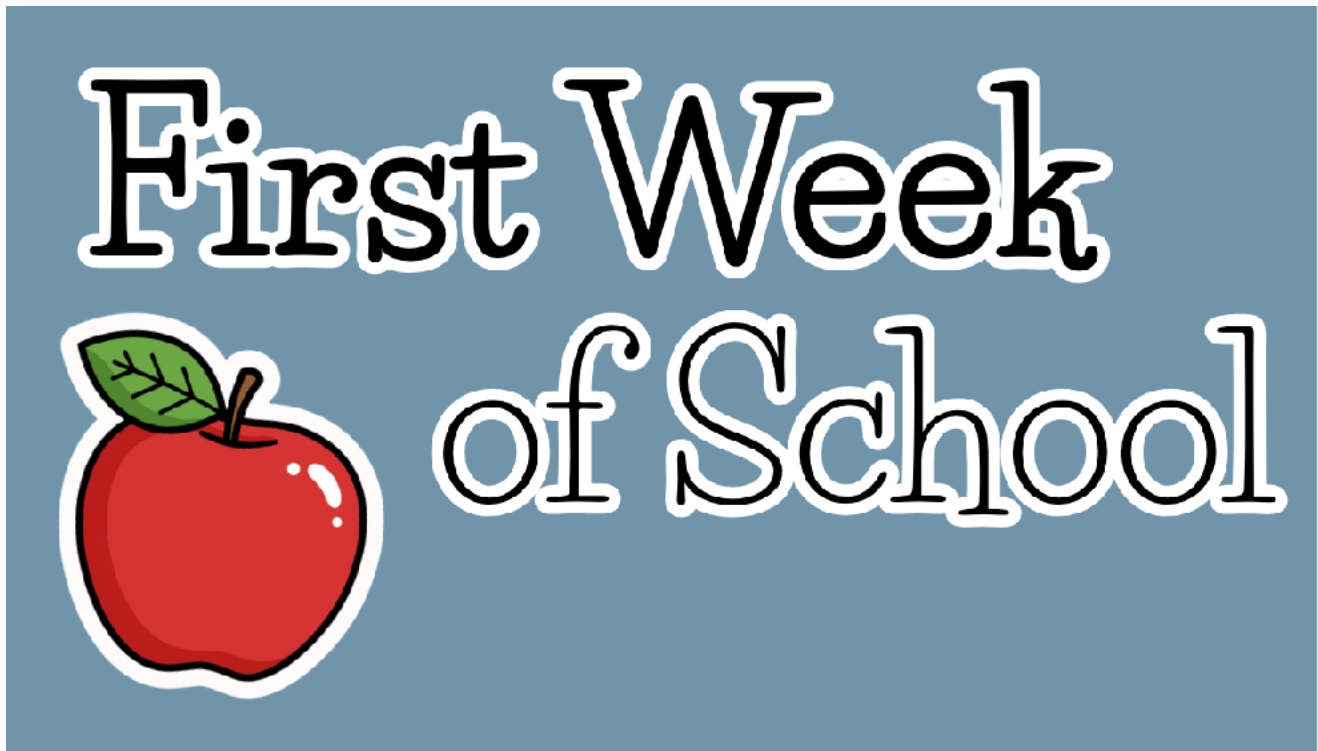
Returning students go to last year's classroom, with the following exception:

New students, please come to the office for a temporary room assignment.

All new Kindergarten students attend 1:00 – 2:00pm (note time correction).

Kindergarten parents are invited to meet with Mrs. Stapleton and Mr. Chan while you are waiting for your children. Please come to Outside Door #25 to hear more about school for Kindergarten students and to ask any questions you may have.

All students enter and exit the school through outside classroom doors, not through the front or side doors.



First Week Plans:

Wednesday, September 9th to Friday, September 11th
Gr. 1 – 7 students attend 8:45 – 2:45 every day

Send a **snack, lunch, and water bottle** with your child in the morning.

PAC operates a hot lunch program once a week, beginning in October, and Libby's Kitchen has meals that can be delivered to your child's classroom. These are the only two lunch deliveries permitted at the school. No other meal delivery services are allowed. We will provide you with the free, Universal Hot Lunch dates and sign-up information when they become available.

Of course, you are welcome to drop off a lunch for your child if you weren't able to send it in the morning.

Students will remain in last year's classroom until attendance is finalized. New students will stay in their temporary room assignment. We hope to move to our new classes some time on Friday.

Picking up your child on Friday, September 11th

Students will have moved to new classrooms during the day on Friday, so they may not be in the room you dropped them off at. **To pick up primary students, please come to the area near the playgrounds. All the primary classes (except Kindergarten) will be waiting there for you. To pick up intermediate students, please arrange a meeting spot before school on Friday so you know where to find each other at the end of the day.**

Kindergarten Students

Kindergarten students attend according to the Gradual Entry Schedule which will be emailed on Monday. Please check carefully to see when to send a snack and lunch, and send a water bottle every day.
